



FIRST ALL-STATE PORTRAIT REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVAL

Sponsored by the South Athletic Booster Club

1. All portraits will be in a brown wood frame with white canvas border.
2. All portraits will be labeled with a bronze plaque with the sport, year and athletes name(s).
3. If an individual athlete or exact same group of athletes receives a subsequent year or years of eligibility of First All-State status in the same sport/event, the bronze plaque will be updated with the additional information at the cost of the Athletic Booster Club.
4. If an athlete or group of athletes chooses to update a photo following an additional First All-State status, they may do so at their own expense. The new portrait will still have to adhere to the requirements of First All-State portrait rules. The Booster Club will only fund one First All-State portrait per athlete or group of athletes.
5. Athletes may choose to wear their sport uniform; it must be the official team uniform or spirit wear.
6. When an athlete chooses not to wear their sport uniform, the following is acceptable:
 - *collared shirt, blazer, suit coat, with or without a tie
 - *solid color long or short sleeve shirts
 - *solid color skirts, dresses, pants or slacks
 - *approved GPS letter jacket
 - *NO blue jeans
7. Background should be plain or with texture. No logos should be affixed.
8. Allowable props would be specific to the specific high school sport used at South, such as caps, goggles, boat oars, towels or balls of the specific sport.
9. The Athletic Director must approve all athletes given this honor.
10. This completed and signed First All-State Portrait Authorization form must be shown to the photographic studio prior to the photo shoot.
