



Grosse Pointe South High School Athletic Event Guidelines and Spectator Policies

Most recently updated on February 8, 2021. Please note that these may change from day to day depending on new information and changes in requirements of governing bodies.

These protocols have been developed using MHSAA guidelines, governor's executive orders, the MDHHS, and the Michigan Safe Schools Road Map.

For all events at Grosse Pointe Public System Schools:

- **All spectators must wear masks at all times, and over the nose and mouth.** Refusal to wear a mask will result in removal from the event.
 - ***MHSAA guidelines regarding safety guidelines will be followed:***
 - ***FACE COVERINGS: Athletes and coaches must wear a face covering or mask at all times except when swimming, wrestling, or during their gymnastics event. This includes practices and competitions. In addition, all coaches must continue to wear a face covering at all times while on GPPSS grounds or facilities. All face covering must meet GPPSS, MDHHS and CDC guidelines. If a face mask/covering does not meet these guidelines the athlete or coach will be provided an alternative face covering in order to compete/coach.***
- All spectators must practice social distancing - requiring 6 feet between family units at all times. Persons not part of the same household should maintain six feet of distance from one another to the fullest extent possible.
- Entrance and exit protocols, and posted signs by host management must be obeyed
- **Each participant/athlete for Basketball, Wrestling, Hockey, and Competitive Cheer will be allowed 2 spectators per event and will be limited to family members only.**
 - The head coach must submit a pass list 48 hours prior to the event. This list will be final, and ***no exceptions will be made for last minute changes.***
- To enter the event, **you must have both the wristband and be on the guest list** (provided by the coach). No exceptions will be made. Your wristband will act as your ticket. Senior citizens (60+) and children 10 and under are admitted for free.

- At this time, the marching band/pep band, and other organizations are not permitted due to MHSAA restrictions.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter our facility 30 minutes before the first game time and will be asked to leave promptly at the conclusion of the game. The stadium/gym will need to be vacant so the spectators for the next game can enter. If athletes are riding with parents they must wait in their cars for their child after the event. *No one will be allowed to enter until the stadium is vacated from the previous game.*
- Tailgating and social gatherings on school campuses and outside facilities (acting as GPPSS home campuses) is NOT allowed.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be positioned throughout the area or facility.
- There will be no concessions offered. No food or drink is allowed onto premises.
- Restrooms will be available at games and events.
- An athletic trainer will be on site for medical needs.
- There is only one entrance to stadium events - For main gym events such as basketball, cheer, and wrestling, all spectators, coaches, officials, and players must enter the Main Gym entrance off of Grosse Pointe Boulevard.
- In the event of inclement weather such as thunder/lightning/tornado, games will be postponed immediately. Because locker rooms/team rooms are not available, this poses a safety issue. We apologize for any inconvenience.
- Failure to abide by the above MHSAA rules will result in forfeiture of the game and/or removal from the facility.
